

**REGULAR MEETING  
MARCH 7, 2023**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Strayer, Batt and Sangialosi, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, Robert Kough, Emergency coordinator, resident, David Sangialosi and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the February 7, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of February 28, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for March 7, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the February 7, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

The road crew cut downed trees on Old RR Bed and Murphy roads. Fixed potholes on Ice House, Leeper Farm, Cold Springs and Bunkerhill. Dragged Ridge Road. Spread stone on Bunkerhill, Ice House and Iron Run roads. Cleaned out ditch on Leaf Road and drain on Bunkerhill Road. Did vehicle maintenance. Had F450 plow fixed. Purchased boards and brackets to hang tools on. Mowed with mower and got mower part fixed.

Secretary Frantz reported that the annual audit was performed with no findings. They requested no payment. The working Supervisor pay is \$17.62. Liquid fuels monies were received in the amount of \$76,141.86.

Supervisors discussed long distance phone service and cost.

Supervisors discussed updating the township computer.

Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman talked about the Forestry burn ban starting March 1 thru May 25, 2023, Quarry Bridge update, cabin numbering issues and the MFA newsletter.

Supervisor Sangialosi gave an update from the WCCOG meeting.

Solicitor McKnight will continue to compose the flood plain ordinance. Zito media continues to be a matter for discussion.

Emergency coordinator, Robert Kough presented an emergency action plan for the buck ridge burn trail half marathon and 5K.

Supervisors held an executive session at 8:44pm where no decisions were made. Reconvened at 8:47pm

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8:48 P.M.
