ORDINANCE # 8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 3 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF COOKE, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY PROHIBITING VANDALISM OF ALL PUBLIC SIGHS ERECTED BY THE TOWNSHIP OR COMMONWEALTH WITHIN SAID TOWNSHIP.

The Township of Cooke, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania hereby ordains as follow:

<u>SECTION 1</u> That section one of Ordinance # 3 be amended as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to tear down, mutilate or in any way deface any signs place in the Township of Cooke which regulate the weight limit of vehicles on bridges, any signs regulating the speed limit of vehicles on Township Roads, and any public signs erected and maintained by the Township of Cooke or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in said Township for any other purpose.

<u>SECTION 2</u> In all other respects said Ordinance shall remain as heretofore enacted.
