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RESOLUTION NO. 2016-04

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND CLARIFY DELINQUENT QUARTERLY TRASH FEES FOR COOKE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as Southampton Township does Quarterly Trash billing in accordance with Ordinances 2011-2 and 2011-3 with attachment, Cooke Township is notified of delinquency after two missed quarterly payments. When Cooke Township receives notification, we will immediately send a letter of delinquency to the offender stating that payment must be made to Southampton Township no later than eight days from date of letter. If Cooke does not receive notification of payment by that date, their toter will be picked up and the matter turned over to the Cooke Township Solicitor for collection. Once the matter is turned over to the Solicitor, the offender shall be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars nor more than One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, plus cost of prosecution if required, including reasonable attorney fees, in addition to a Twenty Five (\$25.00) toter retrieval/replacement fee. Should the offender not respond to the Solicitors letter regarding payment, fine and toter return fee, he shall file a claim with the District Justice.

As delinquency has become an ongoing problem, with some being multiple offenders the following procedure shall be followed, which includes offenses since inception of the trash program:


In the future, anyone whose account has fallen into arrears on three occasions will have their toter permanently removed and will be required to purchase the blue township trash bags for curbside pickup in lots of twelve, payment will be required at the time of purchase. These bags will be collected weekly at curbside the same way trash in the toter is. With this method, there is no monthly bill because the cost of pickup is included in the purchase price of the bags.

All other Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


