

**REGULAR MEETING  
February 6, 2024**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Strayer, Batt and Sangialosi, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, Emergency coordinator Robert Kough Jr., residents Becky Moorehead, Jeff and Margie Schmidt and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the January 2, 2024 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of January 31, 2024, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for February 6, 2024, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the January 2, 2024 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Road crew hauled stone to High Mountain, Peach orchard, and Ridge roads. Took the backhoe for repair and picked up. Plowed snow and put anti-skid and salt on roads during two snow storms. Cut trees up on Ridge, Murphy, and Bunkerhill roads. Purchased tires for the pickup. Fixed Murphy extended and Leaper Farm roads. Cleaned drain pipes out as needed. Took the F450 to D & J's for repair and picked up. Washed vehicles. Patched Old RR Bed potholes. Dragged Iron Run and Cold Springs. Repaired wash out areas.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to increase DD Mersch Hauling rate from \$3.50 to \$3.90 per ton, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Solicitor McKnight gave an update on the Quarry Bridge agreement.

Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman mentioned that there is no update on meeting with Forestry concerning township addresses.

Supervisor Sangialosi gave update from the WCCOG meeting. The WCCOG passed a resolution concerning food processing residual.

Supervisor Strayer attended the MAB meeting. Budget deficit and radios were discussed.

Solicitor McKnight discussed updating the mass gathering ordinance to include the community action plan. Robert Kough requested a separate ordinance for Community action plans. Mr. Kough will send a copy of a Community Action Plan to Solicitor McKnight.

Mr. Kough gave an update on the Gravel Grinder Race response to the Township's permit requirements.

Supervisor Sangialosi to meet with Forestry concerning dead trees along roadway.

Resident Becky Moorehead read from the Constitution.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8:08 P.M.
