ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE VANDALISM OF SIGNS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cooke, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to tear down, mutilate or in any way deface any signs placed in the Township of Cooke which regulate the weight limit of vehicles on roads or bridges, any signs regulating the speed limit of vehicles on Township roads, and any public signs erected and maintained by the Township of Cooke or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in said Township for any other purpose.

2. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance; shall upon conviction thereof before a District Justice, pay a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or on default thereof be imprisoned in the Cumberland County Prison for not more than five (5) days.

3. Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed insofar as it is inconsistent herewith.
