

**REGULAR MEETING**  
**August 6, 2024**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Strayer, Batt and Sangialosi, Solicitor Marcus McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, Robert Kough, Jr., Emergency Coordinator, resident, Becky Moorhead, and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the July 2, 2024 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of July 31, 2024, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for August 6, 2024, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the July 2, 2024 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Roadmaster Kutz cut up trees on Michaux Road, Bendersville Road, and Cold Springs Road. Put in posts and put-up signs on Michaux Road for Toms Run Bridge. Made turnaround larger at end of Old Shippensburg Road. Mowed the beginning of Old Shippensburg Road and Rt. 233 for sight distance. Cut low hanging limbs on Old Shippensburg Road and Old Railroad Bed Road. Mowed Michaux Road, Michaux Oaks Road and Ridge Road in preparation of tar and chip and blacktop. Worked on salt bay in preparation for concrete work. Worked on mower. Dragged Leeper Farm Road due to washout. Put up signs for road closure for tar and chip. Picked up 2x2x6 and 2x2x4 blocks for salt bay and started placing them in salt bay area.

Secretary Frantz reported that the application for dirt and gravel funds was denied but will be considered next year. The Township's email was hacked and a new email will be started. The new email will be [cookeywp@outlook.com](mailto:cookeywp@outlook.com). The Supervisors selected forest green roofing for the pole building. The sign for Old RR Bed Road was stolen and replacement was ordered.

The Supervisors discussed prepaying for a lower rate for propane. Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to prepay Sweetwater Propane for 250 gallons, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Planning committee chairman, Andre Weltman reported that a permit was not required to stabilize the Toms Run Bridge per the Township engineer and the County. He attended a Hazard Mitigation meeting for the 5 year plan.

Supervisor Sangialosi gave update from the WCCOG meeting. Rep. Gleim continues to work on FPR. Rep. Joyce working on proof of citizenship before registering to vote, broadband issues and cell service. The county reported that a second case of West Nile virus was reported and the MDIA contract changed so that small projects have a fee now.

**Supervisor Strayer reported on the Outreach meeting where FPR and new radios were discussed.**

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to ratify the purchase of block for the salt bay divider, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.**

**Solicitor McKnight reported he did not receive a contract from Zito yet.**

**The Ironmasters Challenge is September 22<sup>nd</sup> and the Fall Furnace fest is October 19 & 20. The park is hiring a new manager.**

**Becky Moorhead read a portion of the Constitution.**

**Supervisor Strayer motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8:25 P.M.**
