

**REGULAR MEETING  
JUNE 7, 2022**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Batt, Sangialosi, and Strayer, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman Andre Weltman, Emergency coordinator Robert Kough, residents, Becky Moorehead, Annette Sites, Linda and Barry Smith and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the May 3, 2022 meeting, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of May 31, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for June 7, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the May 3, 2022 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Checked roads. Cleaned up limbs from roads and cleaned out drain pipes and inlets. Cut grass at township building. Took NIMS test. Fixed potholes on High Mountain and Peach orchard. Attended informational session for Quarry Bridge. Fixed block and posted signs on Quarry Bridge. Spread stone and drug dirt roads. Did maintenance on tractor. Patched holes on Pinebrook, Old Railroad Bed, Michaux and Bendersville roads.

Residents Linda and Barry Smith and Annette Sites expressed their concern over renewing the Zito contract. Various complaints were stated. Supervisors discussed options.

Secretary Frantz reported that a building permit for 76 Old Railroad Bed Road was not obtained prior to work being done at cabin. Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to wave penalty and require a valuation and UCC permit, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Planning Chairman, Andre Weltman, reported that a date with the Township, Kirk Stoner and HRG Engineering is being coordinated. Supervisor Batt motioned for Secretary Frantz to advertise the meeting date when finalized, seconded by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi reported on the COG meeting stating that the property owner must provide a signed copy of the project contract to the township when applying for a valuation permit.

Supervisor Strayer reported on the Outreach meeting.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned authorizing Solicitor McKnight to send a letter to 116 Pine Tree Drive concerning delinquent trash payment, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to pay our share of Friendship Hose Co. workers compensation, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to authorize Solicitor McKnight to send a letter to 18 Pinebrook concerning a dog complaint, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

The County is requiring that Emergency Coordinator, Robert Kough send in a report on what is happening in the Township.

The Supervisors went to executive session at 9:00pm and resumed the meeting at 9:05pm. No decisions were made.

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to authorize Supervisor Strayer to talk with employee, Bill Cornman concerning employment, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.**

**Andre Weltman reminded the Supervisors that the Iron Run half marathon and 5K run will be June 11, 2022.**

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting. Second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 9:06 P.M.**
