

**REGULAR MEETING  
AUGUST 1, 2023**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Strayer, Batt and Sangialosi, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, Emergency coordinator, Robert Kough Jr., resident, Becky Moorehead, and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the July 3, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of July 31, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for August 1, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the July 3, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Roadmaster Kutz repaired the fuel tank input site requested by the gas delivery company. Got large rock for Black Swamp Rd. and Ridge Rd. to replace street signs. Cleaned ditch on Bunkerhill Rd. and Murphy Ext. Cleaned up trees and limbs from storms. Cut weeds at guard rails at Bendersville bridge and Old RR Bed Rd. Cleaned drains on several roads. Continued to mow roads. Filled in potholes and cleaned ditches on High Mt. and Peach Orchard. Spread 5-ton 2a's on High Mt. Rd. and 10-ton 2a's on Peach Orchard Rd. Repaired Peach Orchard street sign and reset High Mt. Rd. stop sign.

The Supervisors agreed to extend the building permits for 98 Icehouse and 765 High Mountain Rd.

Supervisor Sangialosi gave an update from the WCCOG meeting. Barb Gleim (199<sup>th</sup> district) reported that the state budget has not been approved yet. Jean Foschi (CC Commissioner) reported that the Commissioners voted to allow the ARP monies be spent on either Motorola or Harris P25 radios. Cumberland County hazardous waste days are August 19 and October 26 from 9am to 3pm by appointment. The WCCOG voted to bid its own salt contract.

Supervisor Strayer reported on the MAB meeting. Discussion at the meeting included the P25 radios and the small bridge program.

Supervisor Batt motioned to authorize Robert Kough Jr to order 1 mobile and 2 portable radios, seconded by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Emergency coordinator, Robert Kough Jr. reported on the Hazard Mitigation meeting and the P25 radios.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8pm.
