

**REGULAR MEETING
JULY 5, 2022**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Batt, Sangialosi, and Strayer, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman Andre Weltman, Emergency coordinator Robert Kough, residents, Becky Moorehead, Steven Day, Barry Smith and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the June 7, 2022 meeting, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of June 30, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for July 5, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the June 7, 2022 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Picked up trash totes at 21 and 116 Pine Tree Drive. Returned trash totes to 116 Pine Tree Drive. Put A/C in the office. Trimmed trees and brush along roads. Drug roads and cleaned ditches. Assisted with paving on Pine Tree and Pinebrook. Cut up downed trees on Camp Lion, Pine Tree and Old Shippensburg roads. Patched holes on High Mountain, Pinebrook and Bendersville roads. Reviewed the ADA area with County and repositioned handicap signs.

Secretary Frantz reported 2022 road projects were finished. The county ARP fund application was emailed. Trash delinquent bill and dog complaint were resolved.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to renew WIX website provider for one year, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Batt motioned to settle CCTB administrative fund with over payment, seconded by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.

Planning Chairman, Andre Weltman, reported that graffiti was found at Camp Michaux twice.

Supervisor Sangialosi reported on the COG meeting. Solicitor Marcus McKnight is contacting VITO media for a representative to attend a meeting.

Supervisor Sangialosi met with the County for review of the ADA parking and ramp area. They took pictures to present to the Board of Elections in September. If the area is approved, residents will receive new voting polling place letters. Voting would be held at the Cooke Township building in November, 2022.

Supervisor Sangialosi reviewed the ongoing Quarry Bridge replacement.

Supervisors discussed paving ½ mile of Bendersville Road in 2023.

Resident Steven Day requested information for a building permit. Solicitor McKnight will review federal/state regulations.

Emergency coordinator, Robert Kough reported on incidents in the township. He also updated on the status of the new radios for the fire company.

Supervisor Batt motioned for Supervisor Sangialosi to contact Forestry to trim or cut down trees on Bunkerhill for AT safety, seconded by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

The Supervisors went to executive session at 8:20pm and resumed the meeting at 8:27pm. No decisions were made.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting. Second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8:28 P.M.
