

**REGULAR MEETING  
November 6, 2023**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Strayer, Batt and Sangialosi, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, residents, Becky Moorehead, David Sangialosi, and Barry Smith, visitors, Ron Tritt, Kyle Snyder, and Brian Nenninger and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the October 3, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of October 31, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for November 6, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Batt motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the October 3, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.

Roadmaster Kutz cleaned limbs off of roads. Mowed, blew off leaves and spread 2A's on quarry and Murphy roads. Graded High Mountain, Peach Orchard roads and Marie Dr. Installed utility parking only sign at remote telephone switch on Ridge Rd. Ordered and received salt. Mixed with anti-skid. Blew leaves off Ridge Rd. and spread 25-ton 2A's. Did winter maintenance on vehicles. Patched holes on Leeper Farm, High Mountain and Peach Orchard roads. Blew leaves off various other roads in the township. Cleaned drains on Ridge and Bendersville roads. Assisted with repair on F550.

Secretary Frantz reported that the fuel tank needs a gauge or whistle installed for safety reasons as requested by delivery company of diesel and gasoline fuels.

Andre Weltman requested any information that the township would like to share in the MFA newsletter.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the salt bid for Morton Salt at \$84.50 per ton, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisors discussed an issue on Beetem Hollow Rd. The matter was tabled for now.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the South Penn Enduro race to be held on September 8, 2024, seconded Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Solicitor McKnight stated that any increase in payment for the Supervisors requires an ordinance and can be changed by resolution if the ordinance states. He will do such ordinance for the next meeting.

Supervisor Strayer motioned to approve the proposed budget for 2024 and advertise in the newspaper, seconded Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

The budgeted road project for 2024 is tar and chipping Michaux Rd., Michaux Oaks Rd. and part of Ridge Rd.

Supervisor Sangialosi reported at the COG meeting a Zito representative attended to hear complaints.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to put out for bid a maintenance building, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to sign the county contract revision signed by county commissioners and if not the current version, authorize to sign correct version, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.**

**Resident Barry Smith asked if a corrected street sign could be posted at the beginning of Pinebrook Dr. Supervisors agreed.**

**Becky Moorehead read an excerpt from the US Constitution.**

**Road worker David Sangialosi asked if High Mountain and Peach Orchard roads were improved since they were graded. It was noted that an area on Peach Orchard needs done again.**

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8:46pm.**
