

**REGULAR MEETING  
APRIL 4, 2023**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Strayer, Batt and Sangialosi, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, residents, David Sangialosi, Barry Smith, Jeff Helt and Becky Moorehead and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the March 7, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of March 31, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for April 4, 2023, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the March 7, 2023 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned for Solicitor McKnight to send a letter to a resident on Pine Tree Dr. concerning a noise and lighting ordinance violation, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

The road crew blew ditches to remove leaves on several township roads. Cut up downed trees on Old Shippensburg and Michaux roads. Dug out the culvert on Bunkerhill. Cleaned on drains on Bendersville Road. Doug Kutz and David Sangialosi went to dirt and gravel certification class. Fixed potholes on High Mountain and Peach Orchard roads. Got the tractor muffler fixed. Prepared markers and installed. Fixed the backhoe maintainer.

Secretary Frantz reported on 109 Pine Tree Dr. building permit progress, the Township computer upgrade and Brightspeed long distance cost per minute at 4 cents for 3 years.

Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman talked about the progress on the bird watching areas on Bunkerhill. The project is not complete at this time. The addresses on several side roads off of Old Shippensburg Road need to be updated and addresses marked for emergency services.

Supervisor Sangialosi gave an update from the WCCOG meeting.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to accept the low bid of Pennsy for road materials. The only exception is Superpave will be purchase at Wilson Paving due to the proximity to the township. Seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to look into purchasing a grader for the dirt roads and proceed to purchase if suitable, seconded by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to purchase a new truck bed for the F550 and sandblast frame, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to install 25mph signs on High Mountain Road as per Ordinance 1990-22, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Discussion by Supervisors concerning the damage to the sides of Ridge Road from vehicles driving off of the dirt road.

Supervisors discussed a blind curve on High Mountain Road and suggested widening the road at the curve.

**The County has started a new small bridge program for bridges between 8'and 20'. Tom's Run would be included in that program. Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to join the program, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.**

**Supervisor Batt motioned to accept the application for 133 Quarry Road for UCC exemption, seconded by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.**

**The Supervisors discussed the Flood Plain Ordinance.**

**Supervisors held an executive session at 9:10pm where no decisions were made. Reconvened at 9:15pm.**

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 9:16pm.**
