

**REGULAR MEETING  
FEBRUARY 2, 2022**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors' was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Batt and Strayer, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, Robert Kough, emergency coordinator, Chris Houck, Park manager, residents, Becky Moorehead, Jeff and Margy Schmidt and Robert Minck, and Secretary Frantz. Supervisor Sangialosi was unable to attend.

Supervisor Batt motioned to approve the minutes of the January 3, 2022 meeting, second by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Batt motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of January 31, 2022, second by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Batt motioned to approve the checks list for February 1, 2022, second by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Batt motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the January 3, 2022 meeting, second by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Road crew checked roads. Cleaned and caulked township building spouting. Repaired potholes and drug dirt roads. Assisted trash truck employees when truck caught on fire in front of the township building. Pretreated roads before snow storm. Plowed roads and applied anti-skid/salt mix on blacktop roads and anti-skid on dirt roads as needed. Ordered salt. Mixed 24.28 ton salt and anti-skid. Put lights on F550 at spreader. Put 1B's on dirt roads at icy spots. Took F550 to D & J's for oil change and picked up. Did maintenance on trucks.

Secretary Frantz reported that the township audit will be on February 12, 2022. Bendersville and Quarry bridge inspections were received.

Supervisor Strayer reported on the outreach meeting he attended.

Motion Supervisor Batt to approve the amended 2022 budget, second Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisors and residents in attendance discussed the lack of trash pickup in the township. Supervisor Batt will discuss with Southampton Township.

Cumberland County Department of Public Safety is holding a symposium to provide awareness to elected officials on their duties as relates to Emergency Management Program on February 12, 2022.

Chris Houck presented signs that will be posted before and after the Bendersville Bridge by the Park concerning foot traffic.

Supervisor Batt motioned to adjourn the meeting. Second by Supervisor Strayer. The meeting adjourned at 8:27 P.M.
