

**REGULAR MEETING  
NOVEMBER 1, 2022**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Batt, Sangialosi, and Strayer, Solicitor Marcus McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman Andre Weltman, emergency coordinator Robert Kough, residents, Becky Moorehead, and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2022 meeting, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of October 31, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for November 1, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the October 4, 2022 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Roadmaster Kutz worked on the mower. Got a bracket for yellow blinking light for backhoe. Checked pipes on Bendersville Rd. Bought new Stihl chain saw and two chains. Filled hole on Quarry Rd. Patched hole and spread stone on Peach Orchard, High Mountain, and Ridge Roads. Met with Negley's concerning water treatment placement and the plumber. Got two new tires for the F550. Dragged Quarry Rd. Blew leaves from various township roads. Got anti-skid for winter. Went to program sponsored by Cumberland Conservation District.

Secretary Frantz reported that furnace cleaning and fire extinguishers need done in November.

Supervisors discussed the Act 57 and increasing tax collector fees for tax certification and duplicate bills.

Planning chairman Andre Weltman reported on the flood plain ordinance.

Supervisor Sangialosi gave an update on the Quarry Bridge. Suggestions and other options were discussed.

Supervisor Sangialosi report that the West Pennsboro Township now can accept credit cards for UCC permits.

The Supervisors discussed the Zito contract renewal. Poor service, cost and loss of channels were complaints from residents. Solicitor McKnight will write a letter to Zito concerning their contract.

Solicitor McKnight discussed with the supervisors about the Newville Fire Company wanting to hire an administrator and the cost.

Supervisor Batt motioned to accept the proposed budget and advertise it, seconded by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to ratify the contract with Wilbur Plumbing and Heating, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.**

**Supervisor Batt motioned to have the older documents scanned at Staples by the Secretary, seconded by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.**

**Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting. Second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8:24 P.M.**
