

**REGULAR MEETING  
DECEMBER 6, 2022**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Batt, Sangialosi, and Strayer, Solicitor Matt McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman Andre Weltman, emergency coordinator Robert Kough, residents, Becky Moorehead, and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the November 1, 2022 meeting, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of November 30, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for December 6, 2022, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the November 1, 2022 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Roadmaster Kutz went to Lowe's for supplies for water system cover and built it. Instructed new employee on use of tractor to blow leaves. Took F450 for inspection and picked up. Put auger on F550. Got fitting fixed for F450. Blew leaves on township roads. Got trucks ready for snow/ice. Plowed blacktop roads. Had plate welded on plow shoe. Patched holes on Ridge and Leeper Farm. Dragged Ridge, Ice house, Old Shippensburg, Peach Orchard, High Mountain, and Cold Springs. Spread 2A's at Ridge /233. Fixed mudhole at turn around on Old Shippensburg.

Supervisor Sangialosi reported on the COG meeting. She was nominated to be Chairperson with Corrie Wadel of Penn Township as Vice Chairperson.

Supervisor Strayer reported on the Outreach meeting.

Supervisor Batt motioned to extend the Zito contract for 6 months, seconded by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adopt Resolution 2022-05 enacting Act 57 of 2022 amending the Local Tax Law, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adopt Resolution 2022-06 adopting the 2023 budget and establishing tax rates, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adopt Resolution 2022-07 adopting the sewage enforcement officer's fee schedule, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Emergency coordinator, Robert Kough reported on the Iron Master's Challenge, Hazard Mitigation, and worker's compensation coverage for fire company and fire police.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting. Second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 7:47 P.M.
