

ORDINANCE # 9

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING AT PROPERLY POSTED AREAS AND PLACES IN COOKE TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

The Township of Cooke, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1 It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor or other vehicle to park such vehicle at the places or areas duly posted with "No Parking" signs which have been authorized by resolution of the Township Supervisors.

SECTION 2 Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, before the proper Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$10.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the Cumberland County Prison for not more than five (5) days.
