

**REGULAR MEETING
APRIL 2, 2019**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors' was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting was Supervisors' Strayer, Batt, and Sangialosi, Solicitor Matthew McKnight, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, and Robert Kough, Emergency coordinator, Kirk Stoner, Cumberland County Planning and Secretary Frantz.

Kirk Stoner, Cumberland County Planning will have his office review the township's comprehensive plan. It should be done by the end of the year. Andre Weltman will assist in the process.

Supervisor Batt motioned to approve the minutes of the March 5, 2019 meeting, second by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of March 31, 2019, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for April 2, 2019, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Batt motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the March 5, 2019 meeting, second by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.

Road crew checked all roads. Plowed and spread all roads. (22-ton 50/50) (8-ton anti-skid) Cut up trees. Spread 2A's on High Mountain, Ice House and Leeper Farm. Spread icy spots on Peach Orchard, Marie, and High Mountain Roads. Lubed garage doors and worked in shop. Did road sign survey. Emptied pick up spreader. Received salt. Took front backhoe tires to Weavers for replacement. Washed pickup and Ford dump. Mixed salt and anti-skid. Washed tractor and GMC dump at Penn. Finished digging up water hydrant and water line. Spread 2A's on High Mountain, Peach Orchard, Iron Run, Ice house, Bunker hill and Ridge. (136 ton) Dragged with tractor Ridge, High Mountain, Peach Orchard, Marie and Iron Run. Cleaned up trees on Michaux and Bunker Hill. Spread 2A's on Ridge and Bunker hill. (42 ton) Dragged Ridge and Bunker hill. Spread 2A's on Ridge, Leaf, Peach Orchard, High Mountain, Iron Run and Leeper. Fixed washout on Marie Dr. (84 ton) Dragged High Mountain, Ridge, Marie, Peach Orchard, and Bunker Hill. Spread 2A's on Old Shippensburg, Icehouse, Quarry, Leeper Farm and Cold Springs. (79ton). Fixed washout on Leeper Farm (9ton) Dragged with tractor Leeper Farm, Ice House and Cold Springs. Dragged Old Shippensburg, Quarry and Iron Run. Hauled 9 ton #8 and 9-ton #1 stone from Pennsy. Looked for reported tree down on Murphy.

Secretary Frantz reported that the liquid fuels account was audited and insurance coverage was reviewed.

Motion by Supervisor Batt to repair drainage on Leaf Road, second by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi reported that at the COG meeting the stone bid results were given to attendees. Motion by Supervisor Sangialosi to approve Pennsy's bid for all stone, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Appalachian Trail sign to be ordered.

Supervisor Batt motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Sangialosi. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
