

**REGULAR MEETING
DECEMBER 1, 2020**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors' was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Sangialosi, Strayer and Batt, Andre Weltman, planning committee chairman, Matthew McKnight, solicitor, Robert Kough, emergency management coordinator, and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the November 2, 2020 meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of *November 30, 2020*, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for December 1, 2020, second by Supervisor Strayer. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Strayer motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the November 2, 2020, second by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Road crew checked all roads and removed limbs during the month. Cut up trees on Bunkerhill, Cold Springs and Michaux roads. Blew leaves on township roads. Hauled 35-ton 2A's to Ridge, 15-ton 2A's to Cold Springs and 5-ton 2A's to Ice House. Dragged High Mountain, Peach Orchard, Leeper Farm, and Cold Springs roads. Replace two stop signs at Ridge and Centerville Roads. Attended meeting with Solicitor McKnight. Patched holes with 2.5 ton of EZ street. Did routine maintenance on equipment and picked up parts. Ordered two tires for backhoe.

Secretary Frantz gave update on High Mountain Road Conservation District grant project and meeting dates. A letter sent to cabin owner not to put leaves in ditch. A letter sent to homeowner to remove stones that were blocking the drain pipe under the road.

Supervisor Sangialosi reported that new regulations for manufactured homes requires an extra application being submitted with MDIA application. Also, the COG dues remain at half dues.

Supervisor Sangialosi gave update on Quarry Bridge.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adopt Ordinance 2020-06 establishing tax rates and budget for 2021, second Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn for an executive session for personnel issue at 7:51pm, second Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous. No decisions were made. Reconvened at 7:53pm.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 7:54 P.M.
