

**REGULAR MEETING
November 1, 2021**

The regular monthly meeting of the Cooke Township Supervisors was held at the Township Building, 1700 Centerville Road, Newville, PA. Present at the meeting were Supervisors' Sangialosi, Batt, and Strayer, Planning Committee Chairman, Andre Weltman, Becky Moorhead, resident, and Secretary Frantz.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the minutes of the October 5, 2021 meeting, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as of October 31, 2021, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the checks list for November 1, 2021, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the ratification of checks written after the October 5, 2021 meeting, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Road crew checked roads. Took drag to welding shop and picked up. Blew Murphy and Quarry roads for Fall Fest at the Park. Took 5-ton 2A's to Quarry. Worked at Penn six days. Graded and dragged Peach Orchard. Dragged High Mountain and Bunkerhill. Got battery and installed in F450. Took F450 for inspection to D & J. Installed no parking signs in cul-de-sac at the end of Pine Tree Drive. Met with contractor for estimate for ADA requirements.

Secretary Frantz reported that the hearing date for 4 Pinebrook was changed to December 13, 2021 at 1:30pm at the district justice office. The salt bid was awarded to Eastern Salt @ \$72.60 per ton thru the COG. The township received \$79.85 from the 904-recycling performance grant 2020.

Supervisor Batt motioned to purchase front tires for the tractor, seconded by Supervisor Sangialosi. Vote unanimous.

Andre Weltman, planning committee chairman, reported that the State Park will post the emergency vehicle only sign if needed at pole steeple.

Supervisor Sangialosi reported on the COG meeting stating that Penndot has no money to update the Exit 37 ramps.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to approve the proposed budget and advertise in the Valley Times, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to contract with DD Mersch Hauling, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Strayer motioned to accept the contract with DL Lehman Construction for the installation of the required ADA updates to the parking lot, seconded by Supervisor Batt. Vote unanimous.

Supervisor Sangialosi motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Supervisor Batt. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
