

ORDINANCE # 1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF REFUSE AND GARBAGE IN COOKE TOWNSHIP AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

The Township of Cooke, Cumberland County, hereby ordains as follows:

1. All refuse and garbage from the Township of Cooke shall be disposed of in the sanitary landfill operated by the Township, and at no other place.
2. All residents or family leaseholders shall pay an annual fee of \$3.00 three Dollars for the privilege of using said landfill.
3. All permanent camps shall pay an annual fee of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars for such privilege.
4. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any agency thereof which desires to use the land fill for trash or garbage from camping, picnicking or other public areas shall pay such annual, monthly, or seasonal fee as shall be from time to time agreed upon with the Board of Township Supervisors.
5. All persons or firms hauling refuse or garbage for others for charge, shall pay an annual license fee of Ten (\$10.00 Dollars per year.
6. All fees for the year 1965 shall be due and payable on or before July 31 and for all subsequent years shall be due and payable on or before July 31 of that year.
7. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars.
8. The Township Supervisors shall from time to time by resolution designate a person and a place at which said fee shall be paid and shall set the compensation to be paid for the collection of such fees.
