AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF COOKE, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHANGING THE REAL ESTATE TAX RATE FOR COOKE TOWNSHIP

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Cooke, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

In order to promote the welfare and common good of the residents of Cooke Township, and due to the increase in costs of fuel, road maintenance, utilities, and insurance the supervisors of Cooke Township do hereby increase the real estate tax mill rate from .000968 to .00150. The increase in tax revenue is estimated to be \$16,686.00. This change will be effective January 1, 2006.

This Ordinance shall take effect on the 5th day after enactment.
